



GCEA-HTF Open Call Funding

Application Guidance

{November 2024}

General

<u>Scope</u>: In this stream, applicants can apply for funding to support any project that falls anywhere the GCEA/HTF remit that can be understood with reference to:

GCEA **Mission**: to maximise the benefits for patients and their care providers from Clinical Engineering expertise and healthcare technology, while minimising the risks and costs

HTF's **Purpose** is to support the GCEA mission by generating, responsibly managing and distributing funds to support education and research that leads to safe, effective, patient-centred, timely, efficient and equitable application of healthcare technology.

Our **Vision** is to achieve significant improvements in global healthcare through the application of healthcare technology.

As such, HTF Open Call Funding Applications are welcomed for any project that falls broadly within this scope. Open Call projects are generally relatively small (see funding available below) with well-defined objectives (outcomes) and timescales. Assessors will be looking for assurance that the project is ambitions but also well managed within these limits of time and money.

<u>Funding Available</u>: While there is no stated limit on funding available for each project, these are generally relative small funding allocations, typically less than \$5,000. HTF are always looking for value for money with all funding applications and particularly welcome applications with matched funding (either direct or in kind). HTF generally looks to fund 1 or 2 projects per funding round but reserves the right to fund more if applications and available funding allow.

Timescales: HTF do not wish to be prescriptive on timescales but will generally be looking for projects that can be delivered in months rather than years. A typical project might run from 8 to 14 months but will obviously be dependent of factors relating to the specific project.

Application Process: Please complete the application form (link). This has been designed to be relatively short and simple to complete but to also discharge HTF's responsibility to ensure appropriate use of charitable funds.

Scoring guideline. The table below is indicative only and presented to help applicants consider how much effort to address to each section. A word limit is assigned to each section. This is a *maximum* limit, applicants are encouraged to be as concise as possible.
